## Required:

To receive the purple seal, the following requirements a-d must be met. For each one not accomplished, the club seal will be lower one color. A-D are assigned monthly through the 4-H Council.

## Seal Requirements:

$\qquad$ To receive a purple seal, the club must have all 4 of the required activities. 25 optional items checked, and at least 1 item from each of the 5 life skills must be included. To receive a blue seal, 3 of the required activities and 20 optional items checked. To receive a red seal, 2 of the required activities and 15 optional items checked. To receive a white seal, 1 of the required activities and 10 optional items checked.
